BECAUSE OF GOD'S GREAT MERCY



Worship program for our congregation

Worship is a gathering of “therefore” people. We have
God’s great mercy. “Therefore”, we work together to
bring God’s mercy in the world through both word and deed. So
to do even more of God’s work, you are encouraged to
share your giving by 1/2 of 1% of your household income.

Follow these simple steps:

1. Take 1/2 of 1% of your annual household income. (Example, \$70,000)

2. Circle the first four numbers from the right. (~~\$70,000~~)

3. Give your offering each week by the remaining amount.
(Example, \$70,000 - \$70,000 = \$0.00 + \$7.00 per week)

4. Give twice a month, multiply the amount by two.
(Example, \$70,000 - \$70,000 = \$0.00 + \$14.00 twice a month)

5. Give four times a month, multiply the amount by four.
(Example, \$70,000 - \$70,000 = \$0.00 + \$28.00 each month)

6. This works for any income, so please use your
own household income.

7. This coming week you will receive a letter and Pledge
Card to indicate your giving for the coming year. Please look for
it and either bring your 2018 Pledge Card to worship

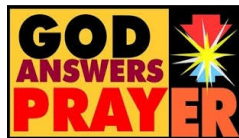
