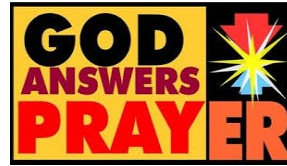

A reading from 1st Samuel, the 2nd chapter.

His mother used to make for him a little robe and take it to him each year, when she went up with her husband to offer the yearly sacrifice.
