





C: Praise the LORD, all you angels; sing praise, all you hosts of heaven.




R: Praise the LORD, sun and moon; sing praise, all you shining stars.

C: who made them stand fast forever and ever, giving them a law that shall not pass away.




R: Praise the LORD from the earth, you sea monsters and all deeps;


C: fire and hail, snow and fog, tempestuous wind, doing God's will;




R: mountains and all hills, fruit trees and all cedars;

C: wild beasts and all cattle, creeping things and flying birds;






C: young men and maidens, old and young together.



C: Praise to you, O Christ.






## HYMN OF THE DAY "The Bells of Christmas"

he descended to the dead. On the third day he rose again; he ascended into heaven, he is seated at the right hand of the Father, and he will come to judge the living and the dead.




I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen.

**P**:



C: And also with you.


